Job Description

Employees assist with community conservation/landcare projects. As part of a project team they work alongside local communities in rural or some urban areas, to actively maintain the environment and to rehabilitate any degraded areas. They will help to identify any problems affecting the local environment and help devise and establish programs or measures that will help overcome those problems and prevent similar ones occurring in the future.

- Plant trees and shrubs
- Carry out natural area restoration works

- Observe and report on plants and/or animals
- Provide on-site information and assistance
- Use business technology
- Process and maintain workplace information
