Certificate III in Horticulture – RTF30103

Job Description

Employees grow and maintain plants and planted areas, construct horticultural features, and apply treatments to improve plant growth and control pests in commercial and domestic gardens. Employees apply sustainability practices to maintain, enhance or protect their resource base and the wider environment.

Summary of Training

- Carry out workplace OH and S procedures
- Lay segmental/unit paving
- Provide information on plants and their culture
- Conduct operational inspection of park facilities
- Implement a maintenance program for an aquatic environment
- Undertake a site assessment
- Control plant pests, diseases and disorders
- Co-ordinate work site activities
- Implement revegetation works
- Co-ordinate a crop regulation program
- Co-ordinate horticultural crop harvesting
- Implement a post-harvest program
- Implement a grassed area maintenance program
- Implement a tree protection program
- Maintain and monitor environmental work practices
- Maintain environmental procedures
